History

The National Association of Scientific Materials Managers was founded in 1974 by a stockroom supervisor at the University of Georgia who was having trouble sourcing supplies and chemicals for his organization. An initial group of 12 who met that first year has steadily grown to a national organization of more than 300 members.

Annual Conference

Annual conferences are rotated among three NAOSMM regions and are usually held in a new location in each region. The 36th annual conference will be held in Boise, Idaho from July 27 - 31, 2009 at the Grove Hotel. NAOSMM's host for the 2009 conference is Mary Ann Stoll, Lab Materials Supervisor at the Idaho State University in Pocatello, ID.
