### **NORFOLK WALKING ADVENTURE**

- Enjoy an informative and leisurely walk through Norfolk's historic downtown and Freemason Area. Departing from the Norfolk Waterside Marriott, your walking adventure will take you past the Half Moone Cruise & Celebration Center, Nauticus, the National Maritime Center, the Battleship Wisconsin and the Lone Sailor Memorial Park.
- You will stroll down the charming cobblestone streets of the Freemason area, home to turn of the century mansions and homes with exquisite architecture. Learn about the history of this charming seaport as your guide shares local legends, three century folklore and stories. Your tour will pass by beautiful historic churches, the downtown financial district, the historic Moses Myers House and old St. Paul's Church where a cannonball fired on New Year's Day, 1776, and is still embedded in the wall!  
**including a REFRESHMENT STOP AT THE PAGODA**
- During your walking tour, enjoy a refreshment stop at the beautiful Pagoda and Oriental Garden, located in the heart of downtown Norfolk. Built in 1989 the Pagoda was a gift to the Commonwealth of Virginia and the City of Norfolk from the Taiwan Provincial Government. The two story octagonal structure features exquisite Chinese architectural details, including a serpentine wall lined with stately Kwansan Cherry trees, a pond side clock, crooked bridge, arched bridge and a ten foot waterfall. The three gated portals are symbolic in form framing an inside view enticing the guest to enter. Guests will be treated to a refreshing beverage and snack before walking back to the hotel.
